New Business: Presentation of Proposed FY 2020-2021 TDA Budget

New Business: Funding Request for Streets of Franklin for \$2,200

Gwen Taylor presented this request. She said the event had been planned out so that vendors would be able to social distance.

Woodard said the Governor's orders would decide whether the event could move forward for July 18th.

Board decided to return to this request after discussion of reimbursement from Springtopia and Cowee Pottery Festival.

Motion by Bishop, second by Woodard to grant the \$2,200 for Streets of Franklin even if the event takes place in September. Motion carried. Vote: 7 to 0.

New Business: Discussion on Funding Reimbursement from Springtopia and Cowee Pottery Festival

Jimbo Ledford detailed the expenses distributed by Jepaca, Inc. in preparation for Sprintopia before COVID-19 forced the event to be cancelled. He said of the \$5,000 granted there was just over \$2,800 that had not been spent. He said that money would be returned.

Woodard said that in conversation with the Town Attorney that it had been decided that Springtopia and Cowee Pottery Festival could supply itemized expenses and then return a check of what was left over. Those entities would need to return a check written to the TDA.

Motion by Presley, second by Woodard to require of Jepaca, Inc. and Cowee Pottery Festival to submit an itemized receipt through the funding report and return any left-over grant money to the TDA. Motion carried. Vote: 7 to 0.
