Dave Lynn – We're coming to you to ask for your assistance for \$2,000 to help with marketing. All the proceeds will go to Cowee Community Development to help out with scholarship programs but also to various needs throughout the community and also to the school.

### New Business: Funding Request for Folk Heritage Association for \$2,000

Theresa Ramsey – I have copies of what we did last year. 64 percent of our budget last year was advertising. We got \$5,000 and we went above and beyond with \$6,333.28. That did not include sign costs or anything like that. This year we're anticipating that our projected annual percentage will be around 61 percent of our budget for advertising. Last year we estimated between 1,500 and 2,000 people were here. We had Macon Early College students do surveys and some of the exhibits had sign in sheets. We were able to determine that we had 18 states represented based on that information.

Summer Woodard – Town Manager – We have been in contact with Premiere Marketing and there were a couple of questions. First, if Site Dart hosted it looked as if it would cost around \$85. However, Premiere said that they can do it in-house and so there would be no charge. They think this is a change that Premiere can oversee themselves.

Motion was made by Woodard, seconded by Bishop to allow the ATC to be hosted on the Discover Franklin site contingent on that there is no cost involved. Motion carried 5 to 0.

Summer Woodard – Town Manager – Here is the insert that the TDC and the TDA jointly funded in the Franklin Press. Also, between now and next month we need to start thinking about the budget. The current budget is at \$113,200 so we need to start thinking of whether we should increase that. I don't know if I would decrease it at all.
